Driving Directions

From Chicago and South-East: Take **I-90 West** towards Rockford. Seven miles past the Elgin Toll Booth, exit on **Hwy. 47 North** towards Woodstock. Drive 13 miles to the stop-light intersection of 47 and 14. Turn left (West) onto **Hwy. 14** and go one mile to the 1st stop light, **Dean Street**. Turn right (North) and follow Dean Street to the second stop sign, **Calhoun Street**. Turn right (East) and drive one block to the first stop sign, **Jefferson Street**. Turn left (north) and go across the train tracks to the Challenger Learning Center, which is on the S.E. corner of Jefferson and Church Streets.

From Waukegan and East: Take **Hwy. 120 West**, through McHenry and into Woodstock. The 1st stop light in Woodstock is Hwy. 47. Cross 47 and drive to the 1st stop sign, **Madison Street**. Turn left (South) on Madison and drive to the 1st stop sign, **Church Street** (You'll see the center on the corner). Go straight and turn right into the parking lot.

Alternate Route from the East: Take **Hwy. 173 West**, through Antioch and Richmond. A few miles past Richmond turn left (South) on **Greenwood Road** (watch for the sign, there is no stop sign or light). Proceed through the village of Greenwood to the 4-way stop with a flashing light above. Proceed straight ahead, which becomes **Hwy. 120** at that 4-way stop. When you arrive in Woodstock the 1st stop light is **Hwy. 47**. Cross 47 and drive to the 1st stop sign, **Madison Street**. Turn left (South) on Madison and drive to the 1st stop sign, **Church Street** (You'll see the center on the corner). Go straight ahead and then turn right into the parking lot.

From Rockford and West: Take **Hwy. 20 East** into Marengo. At the stop light turn left onto **Hwy. 23**. Proceed across the train tracks and turn right onto **Hwy. 176**. Proceed approx. 8 miles to the stop light at **Hwy. 47**. Left (North) on 47 towards Woodstock. Proceed to the stop-light intersection of 47 and **Hwy. 14**. Turn left (West) onto **Hwy. 14** and go one mile to the 1st stop light, **Dean Street**. Turn right (North) and follow Dean Street to the second stop sign, **Calhoun Street**. Turn right (East) and drive one block to the first stop sign, **Jefferson Street**. Turn left (north) and go across the train tracks to the Challenger Learning Center, which is on the S.E. corner of Jefferson and Church Streets.

From Janesville and North-West: Take **Hwy. 14 East** through Wallworth, WI and Harvard, IL. Approaching Woodstock you'll see **Hwy. 120**. Turn left on **120 East** and proceed into Woodstock. (120 becomes Washington Street and then Church Street in town.) Go through the 2nd stop sign, across the railroad tracks, and turn right onto **Jefferson Street** and left into the parking lot.

From Elgin and South: Take **Hwy. 47 North**, through Huntley, towards Woodstock. After crossing over I-90, drive 13 miles to the stop-light intersection of Hwys. 47 and 14. Turn left (West) onto **Hwy. 14** and go one mile to the 1st stop light, **Dean Street**. Turn right (North) and follow Dean Street to the second stop sign, **Calhoun Street**. Turn right (East) and drive one block to the first stop sign, **Jefferson Street**. Turn left (north) and go across the train tracks to the Challenger Learning Center, which is on the S.E. corner of Jefferson and Church Streets.

From Lake Geneva and North: Take **Wisconsin 120 South**, which at the state line becomes **IL 47**. Continue South, through Hebron, and into Woodstock. At the 2nd stop light turn right onto **IL 120**. Proceed to the 1st stop sign, **Madison Street**. Turn left (South) on Madison and drive to the 1st stop sign, **Church Street** (You'll see the center on the corner). Go straight ahead and then turn right into the parking lot.

School Bus Procedures & Protocols

Welcome to Woodstock and thank you for transporting your students and teachers safely and in a timely manner to the Challenger Learning Center! To help you enjoy your day at our center, and in Woodstock, please review the following information.

Traveling to the Challenger Learning Center

- Please arrive on-time or very close to your scheduled time
- If you encounter difficulty during transport, please request your Dispatcher to contact us and provide an approximant time of arrival
- All schools are scheduled to complete missions per prescribed time frames
- Please be aware that we are directly adjacent to the METRA RAIL station
- Follow signs to the Historical Woodstock Square, as we are 1-block NE of the square

Unloading of Students & Teachers at the Challenger Learning Center

- Please enter the Challenger Center's parking lot via the WEST entrance, located on Jefferson Ave. – We are located at the corners of Church Street and Jefferson Ave.
- Please pull-up to the front door and safely discharge all students and teachers
- Please verify that all students have departed the bus, and have removed their lunch from the bus

Parking at the Challenger Learning Center

- After unloading Students at the front door, all school buses are required to park in the southeast corner of the Challenger Learning Center parking lot
- Buses may be left running if required in extreme cold temperatures
- We offer no engine plug-ins
- Restroom facilities are located inside and to the rear of the Center
- Vending machines are available in the lunchroom that is open all day
- Historical Woodstock Square offers several food choices and is within walking distance

Loading of Students and Teachers at the Challenger Learning Center

- We try our best to accommodate schedules, and at times our program may run over, please be patient – we understand that *all* schools operate on a schedule
- Please pull your bus into the parking lot to load students in the same manner as you unloaded upon arrival to the Center
- Exit the Center from any open exit
- During the winter season, loading and unloading of students and teachers may require a few extra minutes – *please be safe and patient*
